THE SEEDS AND PLANT VARIETIES ACT

(Cap.326)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by sections 21,24 and 28(2) of the Seeds and Plant Varieties Act, the Minister for Agriculture, Livestock Development and Marketing In akes the following Regulations:
